### Mezzanine International Group

The following represents the policy of **Mezzanine International Group** (and **Mezzanine International Limited**), hereinafter referred to as **Mezzanine International** in respect to “BIM Policy”.

### 1 Scope

1.1 This document sets out the Building Information Management (BIM) Policy of Mezzanine International in relation to all offices.

### 2 Policy Summary

2.1 Mezzanine International is committed to developing BIM capabilities to provide a consistent level of service across all disciplines and offices. We are aware that the UK construction industry’s understanding of the use and benefits of BIM is still developing, and we are committed to continued investment in training to ensure the abilities of our staff develop in line with the evolution of the use of BIM in practice.

### 3 Responsibilities

3.1 The Mezzanine International Senior Management Meeting Team (SMT) is responsible for the delivery of the BIM Policy, with day to day delivery delegated to the BIM Group, comprising representatives from each discipline and relevant office.

### 4 Background

4.1 Mezzanine International has been developing our 5D time- and cost-saving capabilities since 2011, but adoption of BIM compliant methods of works commenced in earnest in 2016, with a plan to achieve BIM level 2 readiness for 2017.
